**Our goal is to provide a safe and enjoyable Woodshop Amenity to all our members.**

**Woodshop Amenity Mission Statement**

The Hideout Woodshop amenity is a fully equipped Woodshop which is open to members in good standing and guests who have taken the required safety course and paid the yearly amenity fee. It is also home to The Hideout Woodworkers Club. Now is the time to start that woodworking project you have always wanted to make. You do not have to be a member of The Hideout Woodworkers Club to utilize the amenity but must take the proper safety course.

Woodshop Amenity Fee 2026

Member- \$50.00

Guest - \$75.00

Fees must be paid before utilizing the amenity.

**1. Define the Woodshop Amenity**

The Woodshop Amenity consists of two distinct areas; a well-equipped woodworking facility, and an attached social area. The woodworking area of the Woodshop Amenity is only available to be used by any community member in good standing who has paid the annual amenity fee, has successfully completed the required safety training course/s and agrees to comply with the Amenity rules. The woodshop safety course dates will be posted at Recreation. A trained member of The Recreation Staff will teach the safety course.

Prorating of Amenity fees will be determined by the Recreation Department on time that community members join the Woodshop Amenity.

**2. Define a "Woodworker"**

Any member who has paid the amenity fee, had the required safety courses and has signed a Woodshop Agreement will receive a Woodworker's sticker to be applied to the back of the member's community ID.. The member, having completed all the requirements to utilize the Woodshop equipment, will be referred to as a "Woodworker".

No affiliation to any club/s professional organizations etc. is required.

**3. Define Woodshop Amenity rules**

- a) Only Woodworkers may utilize the workshop and will have access to the Woodshop during posted hours
- b) you must be 18 years and older to use the woodshop facility
- c) Personal safety equipment (safety glasses, shields, ear plugs etc.) that are required based on the project/ activity are the woodworker's responsibility.
- d) Woodworkers are required to check in and check out with woodshop employee and must comply with all shop safety rules and proper equipment operation.
- e) Each Woodworker is responsible for whatever consumable materials/ supplies are needed for their project (wood, glue, sandpaper, stain etc.)
- f) Upon completion of their work activity the Woodworker must return/restore all tools to their proper storage area and clean up their work-area. All combustible material must be stored properly.
- g) Any unsafe condition or action should immediately be reported to Woodshop employee,
- h) Any/all accidents or injuries must be reported to Woodshop employee and Public Safety, 698-4100, ext. 144.
- i) Any need for major calibration/repair shall be reported to the Recreation Manager, 698-4100 ext. 163.
- j) The Woodshop Amenity's tools are not to be removed from the workshop.
- k) Any Woodworker utilizing the woodshop shall attend the required training as designated by the Board of Directors.
- l) This Amenity is available for the recreational woodworker & hobbyist. All items made must be for personal use, gift, or donation and NOT to be sold.
- m) All personal projects are to be completed and removed from the shop no later than 30 days after the start of the project.
- n) Any personal projects left in the shop must have a name and start date on the project.

**I understand and will comply with the Woodshop Amenity Procedures and Rules listed above.**
